





Steps for Create, Delete, Rename and View the Directory Listing in Navision


1. Open object designer and Import the Fob "Folder List.fob" in your database see below




2. Run form 50002 from object designer it looks like below



3. Click on the lookup button, A Folder List form will be open like below shown




4. On the Browse Folder tab click on the lookup button to see the list of drive in your system and select c drive




5. Now you can see in the "Folder Name" list box a list of directory contained in your c drive if you want to brows the folder listed in "Folder Name" list box select like "Documents and


Settings” the folder you want to browse and click assist button you can see the list of directory in selected folder “Documents and Settings” see below
