


Menu Search Assistant - Instructions

The agiles Menu Search Assistant helps users to find menu items within the Microsoft Dynamics NAV menu. If you would like to use the agiles menu search assistant, please follow these short instructions.


Please note: this is for more technical users. If you are a Microsoft Dynamics NAV customer please speak to your NAV partner about this tool.

Step 1: Import the MenuSearch.fob which is provided in the Extras folder on the agilesWorkflow CD. The 68000 Number Range is used with the Version List Tag "MENUSRC".





Step 2: Export the MenuSuite in text format.




Step 3: Run Form 68005 Menu Search.




Step 4: On the Functions button, open the "Import MenuSuite" function and import the MenuSuite in text format (which you exported previously).



The MenuSuite is imported into the Menu Search Form



After the import, the Menu Search form is populated.



Step 5: You can use now use the “Name Filter” field to search for items on the menu, by typing in the name and selecting enter.

You can open the form from the “Run Form” button or you can see the path to the menu item on the bottom of the screen.
