

# NAV-JavaScript communication sample

---

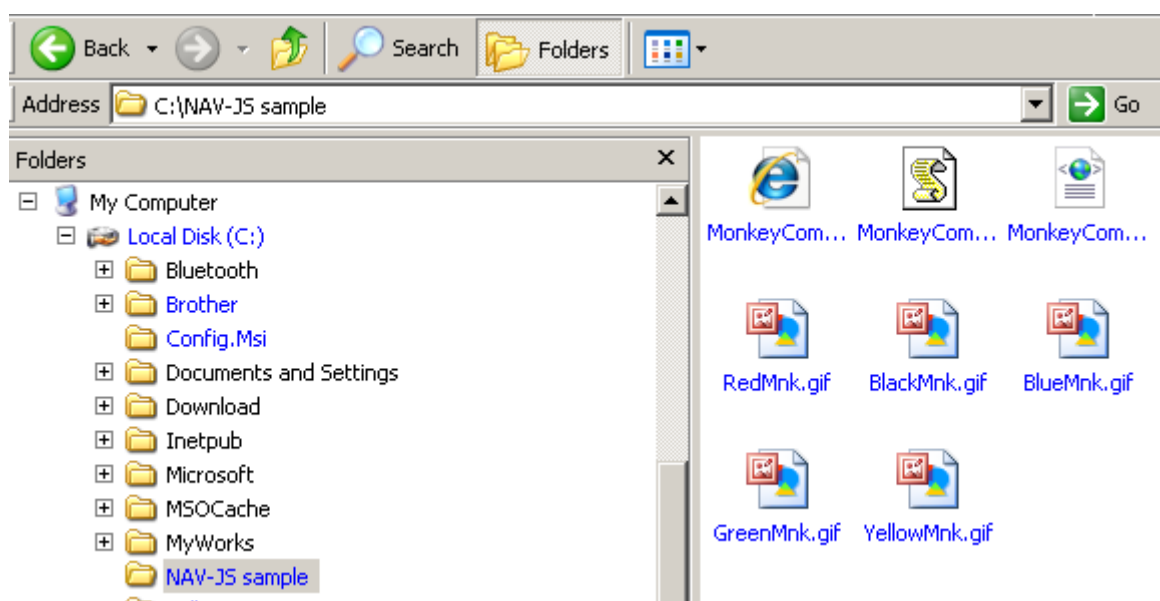
The communication sample demonstrates communication between Microsoft Dynamics NAV and JavaScript components of the Dynamic HTML document. In this sample NAV-data is transferred into the contents of HTML document. In the HTML document you can use Drag-and-Drop function, edit text or change pictures. The changed contents will be sent back to NAVISION via XML.

I did not put the purpose to create a script which works in all web browsers. This sample has been tested in IE7.

## To build the sample

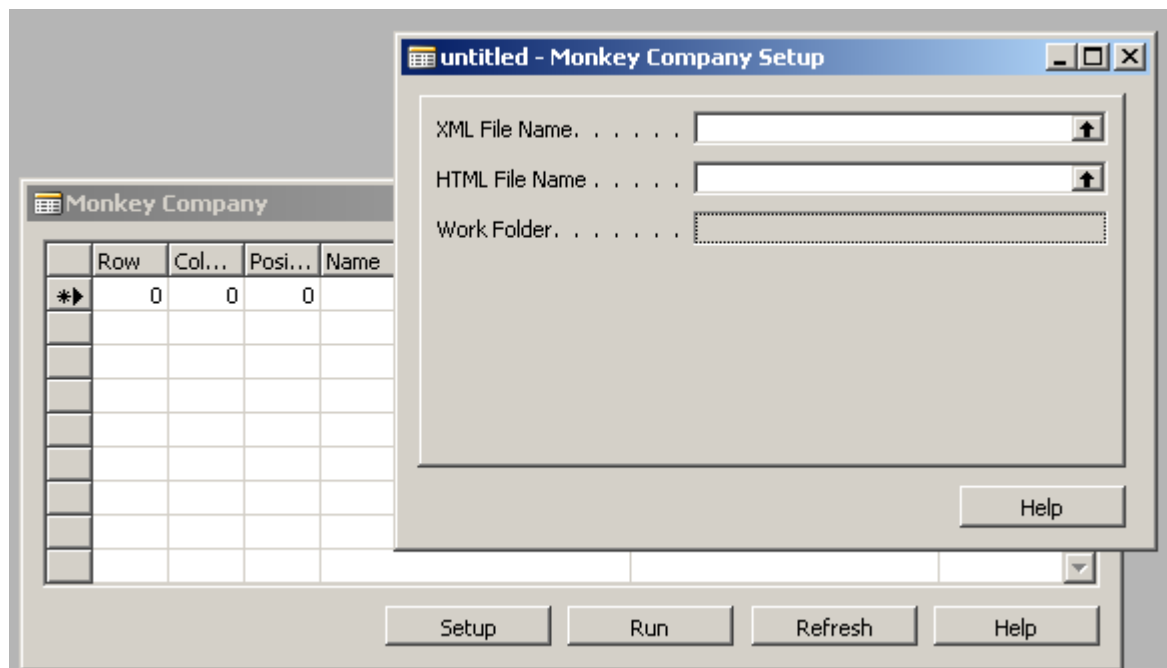
1. Create a new **work folder** and call it for example **NAV-JS sample**.
2. Put the following files into that folder:
  - a. MonkeyCompany.htm
  - b. MonkeyCompany.js
  - c. MonkeyCompany.xml
  - d. BlackMnk.gif .. YellowMnk.gif



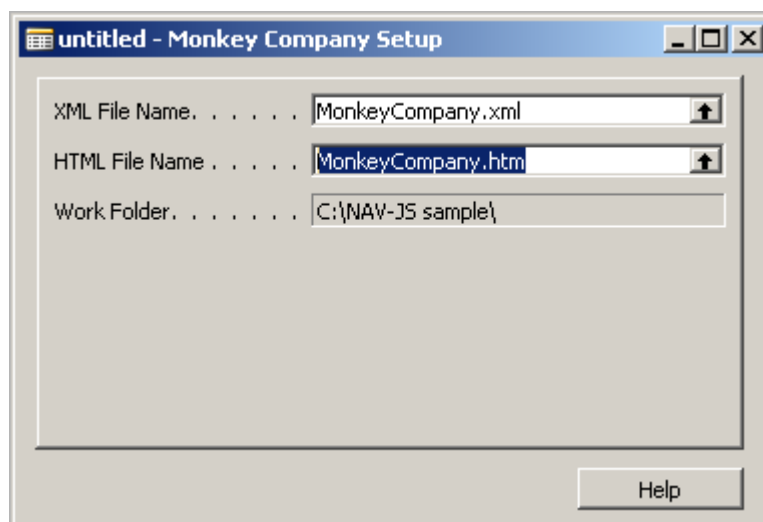
3. Import the **"NAV-JS CommSampleFOB.fob"** into a MS Dynamics NAV database.

## To run the sample

1. Run Form 50 000 **Monkey Company** and click the **Setup** button.



2. In the **XML File Name** field click the Lookup and select the **MonkeyCompany.xml** from Work Folder.
3. In the **HTML File Name** field click the Lookup and select the **MonkeyCompany.htm** from Work Folder.











4. Close the **Setup** Form and click the **Refresh** button.

6. You can **drag-and-drop** the images from one cell to another cell or change the **Name**, **Job Title** and **Color**.





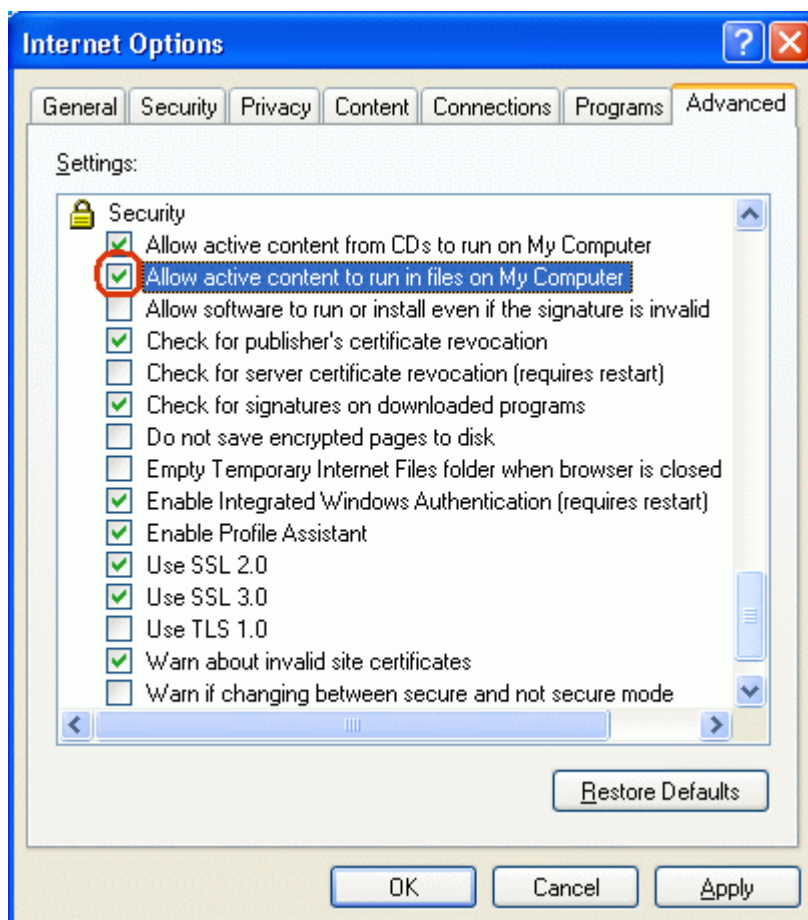

\* - Follow the steps below if you are tired of having to "Enable Blocked Content" in Internet Explorer:

1. From Internet Explorer, select the *Tools* menu, then the *Options...*
2. In *Options* dialog, select the *Advanced* tab...
3. Scroll down until you see the Security options. Enable the checkbox **"Allow active content to run in files on My Computer"**.



4. Close the dialog, and quit Internet Explorer. The changes will take effect the next time you start IE.
